TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. OUTLINE

These Terms of Reference outline the minimum Scope of Work for which the Supplier or Service Provider is responsible. It defines key activities and what the Supplier is responsible for supplying, delivering and installation i.e. the required outcomes as a result of Infrastructure Maintenance.

2. BACKGOUND

Winnie Madikizela Mandela Local Municipality falls within the jurisdiction of Alfred Nzo District of the Eastern Cape Province. The municipality has a valid NERSA approved distribution license to the residents of Bizana. NERSA conducted a Compliance Audit and Monitoring within the Municipality and has issued a draft report with recommendations and corrective actions that municipality must implement. The compliance monitoring exercise is done to make sure that municipality complies with Electricity Distribution Regulations.

4 CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT

Compliance with and performance in terms of the Terms of Reference is a specific condition of the appointment of Previous Experience in Electrical infrastructure maintenance projects. The Municipality will provide all relevant information available for successfully completing the project. The delivery lead time from date of appointment is 4 months.

5 QUALITY AND QUANTITY
