1. PURPOSE

The Kwazulu-Natal Growth Fund Trust (KGFT) invites quotations from suitably qualified service providers to provide KGFT with Fifteen SABS Approved Personal Protective Equipment

2. BACKGROUND

KZN Growth Fund Trust (KGFT) is a Trust, established and capitalised by the Provincial Government to **provide** debt and equity. The main objective of the KGFT is to provide support for creating an enabling environment for activities that create jobs and accelerate the economic development of KZN whilst promoting Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE).

2.1 Procurement Philosophy

(b)	recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct;
(c)	cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation;
(d)	recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the audi alteram partem (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
(e)	forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.
