The tenderer must have a CIDB grading of 7CEPE or Higher. The tender that fails to meet the stipulated criteria will be regarded as non-responsive.

Any tender submitted by a person(s) who is in the service of the state or if that person(s) is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state or who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the Municipality shall not be considered in terms of regulation 44 of the Municipal Supply Chain Regulations. Only suppliers who are registered on Central Supplier Data Base (CSD, visit the CSD website at [www.csd.gov.za](http://www.csd.gov.za)) can apply for these tenders. All suppliers applying for these tenders must register on the Municipal database
