INTRODUCTION

Sakhisizwe Local Municipality is undertaking a project of legalizing the Sakhisizwe land fill site by requesting the service provider to conduct a S24G process in terms of NEMA. The SLM received the Waste Management License on 05 June 2012. The Waste Management License expired on 05 June 2017. The DEDEAT Environmental Management Inspector has inspected the landfill site and has issued the intention to prosecute and recommended that the Sakhisizwe Local Municipality apply for rectification of unlawful activities in terms of S24G of NEMA.
