The King Cetshwayo District Municipality will strive to achieve targeted procurement in accordance with Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act Regulation 2022 as outlined in the table below. The tenderer must also have a CIDB grading of 8CE and 8ME. The tenderer that fails to meet the stipulated criteria will be regarded as non-responsive.

Any tender submitted by a person(s) who is in the service of the state or if that person(s) is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder, or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state or who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the Municipality shall not be considered in terms of regulation 44 of the Municipal Supply Chain Regulations. National Treasury has introduced the Central Supplier Database (CSD), where all suppliers are required to register.
