George Municipality invites tenders for tender no: **ENG 001/2023** for **UPGRADING OF HEROLDS BAY 66/11KV SUBSTATION IN GEORGE**. The project is planned to be executed over the 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25 financial years.

Only bidders who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Standard Conditions of Bid (Clause C.2.1) are eligible to submit tenders.

It is estimated that tenderers should have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 5EP or higher.

Proven previous experience in **BOTH 66/11kV substation related projects and 66 kV steel monopole overhead line related projects** are required and is part of the eligibility criteria of this tender.

NO PORCELAIN OR GLASS INSULATORS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY EQUIPMENT IN THE OUTDOOR YARD AND BIDDERS MUST PRICE ACCORDINGLY.

All bids received shall be evaluated in terms of the George Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy, read with the Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2022. It is estimated that the 80/20 preference points system will be applicable. Tenders will be evaluated in terms of price and preference.
