## 2. DEFINITIONS

- (c) **“rand value”** means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bid invitation, and includes all applicable taxes;
- (d) **“tender for income-generating contracts”** means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of income-generating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and a third party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and

#### 1. Introduction / Background

The Municipal Infrastructure Support Agent (MISA) requires the services of an experienced and accredited training provider to deliver GRAP (Generally Recognised Accounting Practice) Training to officials working within the Management Accounting, Financial Accounting and Asset management environment.

The main purpose of this training is to ensure that finance practitioners understand the application of GRAP standards in the preparation and reporting of public sector financial statements and can implement compliant financial practices as required by National Treasury and the Accounting Standards Board.

#### 2. Scope of Work

The appointed service provider will be required to:

- Deliver training covering key GRAP Standards including, but not limited to:
- GRAP Framework
- GRAP on Assets (PPE, Intangible assets, etc.)
- GRAP 109
- GRAP on Liabilities, Revenue and Expenditure
- GRAP Financial Statement Preparation and Disclosure Requirements

Provide the training within the Gauteng Province, including:

- Training venue and facilities
