#### 4.1. INTRODUCTION

The existing centralized HVAC system has reached its lifespan and the units experience constant breakages. The system is the highest contributor to energy consumption within the buildings and therefore needs to be replaced. The objective is to replace the existing units with a new energy-efficient HVAC system to allow the building to maintain comfortable indoor temperatures and environment.

As a result of the required HVAC upgrades, AIDC requires the services of an ECSA registered professional mechanical engineer to undertake HVAC Services throughout the project life cycle from (Stage 1 – Stage 6)
