SPECIFICATIONS

The general specifications of the camera are, but not limited to:

- High sensitivity solar blind UV detector.
- Optical 25 Hz FLIR Radiometric LWIR camera module.
- Synchronized Smooth or Stepped Zoom of all 3 camera channels.
- IR, UV and Visible channels zoom. Optical zoom is preferred.
- Manual or Auto focus for Visible channel, UV & LWIR channels. The channels should also be capable of manual fine tuning.
- Onboard still image, video and radiometric data recording.
- Meta data recording of camera settings and measurement. Should be the capability to capture environmental variables (distance, ambient temperature, pressure, humidity, wind speed, etc.
- The set-up and boot up should be as fast as possible. There should be options of power saving modes to save battery.
- Manual or Auto Exposure of Visible and LWIR (Level) cameras,
- UV (Gain) setting.

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- Easy & comfortable operation of the camera there should be multi-function interface keys that allow for easy access to UV, IR and Vis and the gain and levels functions.
- Control over UV overlay colors, UV overlay translucency, UV threshold, Integration & Noise Reduction control.
- IR colour palettes with contrasting Isotherms.
- Auto or Manual IR Span.
- GPS capability.
- Integrated high power LED laser for identification of components. An integrated flashlight would be advantageous for low light conditions.
- Camera software updates should be available.

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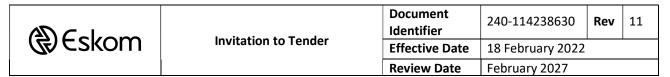
