2	Environmental Management Plan	A contractor must develop a projects-specific Environmental Management Plan (EMP) . The EMP should identify all potential environmental aspects and impacts associated with the project's activities, for example, waste generation, noise, and Dust ▪ The EMP must outline the mitigation measures, monitoring procedures, and responsibilities. ▪ The EMP will be reviewed and approve it before the project commences
3.	Waste Management Plan	A contractor to develop Waste Management to ensure that al waste generated during the project's life cycle is identified, handled and disposed in compliance with the SHEQ standard, National Environmental Management Waste Act and the relevant Waste Bylaws.

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4.	Emergency Preparedness Plan	The contractor is required to develop and implement an Emergency Preparedness Plan to effectively respond to environmental incidents that may arise during firebreak preparation activities, including but not limited to wildfires, fuel spills, and adverse weather conditions.
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
