KATHU ANC defends new mayor & speaker appointments at Gamagara

Following the Kathu Gazette reporting that a new mayor and a new speaker had unlawfully been appointed at the Gamagara local municipality last week, the John Taolo Gaetsewe Regional Executive Committee (JTG REC) of the ANC reacted vehemently in a statement dated 11 August 2023, accusing the Kathu Gazette of having published an opportunistic and misleading article about the events that had led to these appointments.

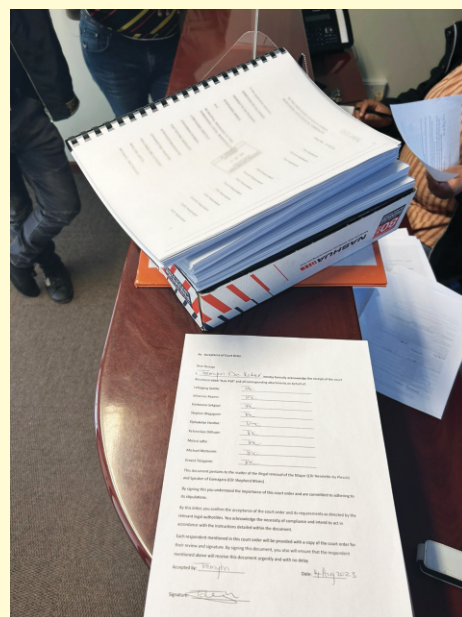
The article published in the Kathu Gazette dated 12 August 2023 referred to the controversial proceedings at the ordinary council meeting held at Gamagara municipality on 07 August 2023 during which a new mayor and speaker were appointed without representatives of the Democratic Alliance (DA) nor the Gamagara Community Forum (GCF).

In the communication issued by the REC, the article is described as peddling lies, misinforming the public, using the situation at hand to sway public opinion and bolstering the opposition ahead of the 2024 national general elections.

The REC referred to the article where it had been reported that the ANC caucus had disrupted council and had forged ties with the EFF in appointing a new mayor and a new speaker. The REC said that these had been lies and that the article was a desperate effort to spark confusion, not only within the public, but an attempt to demoralise the staff members at the Gamagara municipality.

The REC called on the former mayor and speaker to accept that they had been removed legally and to stop tarnishing the ANC.

The REC pointed out that a previous council meeting did not take place due to a quorum not having been reached, but that the

items on the agenda had not lapsed until tabled before council, asserting that no item on an agenda can lapse unless approved or rejected by council.

The REC went on to state in the communication that they wanted to assure the public that all procedures taken at that last council meeting dated 07 August 2023 were legally sound in line with the constitution and that the new mayor and speaker had been legally elected. According to the REC there had been sufficient remaining councillors after the mayor and speaker and one DA council-

lor had left council to form a quorum and therefor council could proceed with the motions of no confidence.

The REC is of the belief that the mayor, the speaker and a DA councillor had violated the Councillor's Code of Conduct when they apparently walked out of the meeting, thus abandoning their lawful responsibilities towards the communities they represented.

The REC stated that the DA mayor Councillor Henriëtte du Plessis and the Gamagara Community Forum speaker Councillor Shepherd Mines were removed in the same way they had assumed office two months ago. The REC believes that the current outcome is a reflection of the will of the people and that the outcome of the 2021 local government election has been upheld.

The REC went on to state that the DA is a party of spoilt brats who had assumed that their victory recently was going to last for ever.

The Premier of the Northern Cape Dr Zaman Saul posted on his Facebook page that very productive meetings had been held with the branch executive councils in the Gamagara sub-region, JTG region. He went to say that the ANC had regained the Gamagara municipality and that the ANC will fiercely defend it even in a court of law. He added that the ANC was on track with preparations to gain a decisive victory in 2024.

Meanwhile the DA has served a court order on the remaining councillors who had out voted the mayor and speaker and voted in the new mayor Councillor Roman Johannes Mano and the new speaker Councillor Goitseone Sekgopi and the case will be heard in the High Court in Kimberley on Thursday 31 August 2023.

The DA and the GCF are adamant that the procedure to out vote them had been unconstitutional.
