Late proposals or proposals received by way of post, facsimile or e-mail will, under no circumstances, be considered.

The Ndwedwe Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Framework Act, Act 5 of 2000, new 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2022.

Bids shall be valid for a period of **120 days**. The Ndwedwe Local Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest, or any bid, either wholly or in part or give any reason for such action.

Bidders are advised not to commit fraudulent activities or forge documents.
