## The South African National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL) invites tenders for ROUTINE ROAD MAINTENANCE WORKS ACROSS SOUTH AFRICA

Projects will be based in all South African 9 Provinces on an as and when required basis during the period of five (5) years.

Bidders shall confirm and indicate Provinces that they are able to perform the works. Maximum of 15 Bidder will be appointed and placed in a Panel. Works will be allocated to contractors on the Panel on rotation basis taking into account Contractor capacity, Contractor available resources, Works location (Province) and performance on other awarded projects.

Only tenderers who are a CIDB contractor grading of **7CE or higher** as stated on the Tender Data may submit tender offers.

Tenders from tenderers registered as potentially emerging enterprises with a CIDB contractor grading designation lower than a contractor grading designation required for this tender, will not be accepted.

Only tenderers who are registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database are eligible to tender.

#### **TENDER DOCUMENTS**

Tender documents are available from **8 November 2024** for free download from National Treasury's eTender Publication Portal (http://www.etenders.gov.za) and CIDB Website.

#### A compulsory briefing session

### Stage 3 Functionality Evaluation Criteria

Functionality is the terminology used to define the technical ability of the Tenderer, based on experience to deliver the required product in accordance with the specialized quality, reliability, and functionality.

The functionality evaluation will be conducted by the Bid Evaluation Committee which comprises of various skilled and experienced members from diverse professional disciplines. The evaluation process will be based on functionality criteria. The criteria will be as follows:

Points allocated for Functionality shall be evaluated in accordance with the criteria as listed below. Total quality points allocated shall be 100. Tenderer must score minimum score per each sub-criterion and an overall minimum threshold of **75 points** out of 100 is required to be achieved for the tender to be eligible for further evaluation.

Bidder shall submit a list of projects relevant/similar to this tender scope of work which have been successfully completed within the last 15 years. Contactable client reference details/letter or

Certificates of Practical Completion/ Letter of Award are required for the stated projects.

- 5. Rise and fall adjustments shall only be made upon receipt by the engineer of the appropriate letters of supply in compliance to note 4 above, but with the changed supply prices and date of application, as well as reasons for the changes.
- 6. A change of supplier may be permitted, but only upon application to the engineer with the appropriate letters of supply in compliance to Note 4 above and approval thereof.
- 7. Non-disclosure of reduction in supply prices shall be deemed a contractor's deliberate action to defraud the Employer and grounds for the Employer, at its sole discretion, to terminate the contract.
