2003 (Act 57 of 2003); with the mandate to conserve; protect; control; and

manage national parks and other defined protected areas and their

biological diversity (Biodiversity). As a public entity, SANParks is also

governed by the Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999 (as

amended by Act 29 of 1999), and it is listed as Schedule 3 Part A: public

entities.
