Meder maintains medal momentum on Swimming World Cup circuit

SA star captures bronze in Westmont, Illinois, finishing behind Olympic champion Kate Douglass and Alex Walsh

SA's Rebecca Meder returned to the podium at the second stop of the World Aquatics Swimming World Cup series in Westmont, Illinois, at the weekend.

The 23-year-old added to her haul of two bronze medals from the first stop a week earlier with another bronze in the 200m breaststroke on Saturday.

Meder stopped the clock on two minutes 18.88 seconds to secure third spot behind Olympic champion Kate Douglass, who took the gold in 2:14.57 and fellow Amer-

ican Alex Walsh, who edged the SA swimmer for the silver in 2:18.54. The New Zealand-based star, who reached all the finals of her respective events, finished fifth in the 100m breaststroke in 1:05.35.

The race was won in 1:03.14 by Douglass, who also set a world record in the 100m freestyle over the weekend.

Ireland's Mona McSharry took silver in 1:04.18 and Walsh the bronze in 1:04.45.

After topping the time sheets in the heats of the 200m individual medley, Meder finished fifth in the final in 2:07.60.

Walsh won gold in 2:04.44, while silver went to Israel's Anastasia Gorbenko in 2:04.93 and bronze to Britain's Abbie Wood in 2:05.73.

Meder finished seventh in her other event of the meet — the

100m individual medley — in 58.31 seconds. The race was won by Gretchen Walsh of the US in a World Cup record time of 55.77 seconds.

While her times weren't as quick as they were at the opening stop of

the series in Carmel, Meder was pleased with her overall performance, which led to SA finishing 18th on the medal table, thanks to her breaststroke bronze.

"It was another solid weekend of racing. Unfortunately, I started

fighting a head cold on Wednesday, but I am grateful that I made finals for all of my races and finished 17th overall for this stop," she said.

"The 200 and 100 breaststroke events are relatively new (I've only

been racing them internationally for a year), so I am grateful for this experience where I get to race the world's best and to learn and grow with every race.

"I am looking forward to another weekend of racing in Canada."

The third and final stop of the World Aquatics Swimming World Cup series takes place in Toronto this week, from October 23-25.

Meder heads into the competition now ranked 14th overall in the women's World Cup standings. Her coach, Graham Hill, said the experience racing against the likes of Douglass and Walsh had been invaluable.

"Hopefully the race experience she will gain from the three stops will move her to another level when she races at competitions such as the Commonwealth Games and Olympics." — *Swimming SA*

Liverpool return 'theoretically possible' but Slot will turn things around, says Klopp

Former Liverpool soccer manager Jurgen Klopp says it is "theoretically possible" he could return to the Anfield hot seat one day, but he is convinced current boss Arne Slot will guide the club through the rough patch they are experiencing.

Klopp left Liverpool at the end of the 2023-2024 season after leading the Merseyside club to almost every major honour during his nine-year spell, including Champions League and English Premier League triumphs.

The 58-year-old German was succeeded by Slot, who became the first Dutch manager to win the Premier League.

"I said I will never coach a different team in England so that means if (I go back), then it's Liverpool. So yeah, theoretically it's possible," Klopp said on The Diary of a CEO podcast.

However, he said he was content in his current role as head of global soccer for Red Bull.

"I love what I do now. I don't miss coaching. I do coach but it's just different, it's not players," Klopp said.

"I don't miss standing in the rain for two-and-a-half or three hours. I also don't miss going to press conferences three times a week. I don't miss being in the dressing room."

"I'm 58. From your perspective that might be old, but from

other perspectives, it's not that old. That means I could decide in a few years. I don't know."

Liverpool have suffered four consecutive defeats for the first time since November 2014 after Sunday's 2-1 home loss to Manchester United but Klopp was confident Slot would turn things around with players such as Florian Wirtz and Hugo Ekitike at his disposal.

"Wirtz, you all will eat your words if you use the wrong words. He's an incredible talent," he said. "Ekitike, incredible player. Just the offensive players; it's a really, really good squad."

"So you don't have to worry about Liverpool; they will be fine."

Meanwhile, Liverpool talisman Mohamed Salah's form has dipped to such an extent that he should not be considered an automatic starter away from home, former defender Jamie Carragher said.

The 33-year-old Egyptian forward, who signed a two-year contract extension in April, has been way below his record-breaking form from last season's campaign and has gone seven matches without a non-penalty goal.

Salah squandered a golden opportunity to score in Liverpool's defeat by Manchester United and Carragher said he should not be one of the first names on the team sheet such as captain Virgil van Dijk. — *Reuters*

Soccer community mourns death of popular administrator Leonard Marillier

East London and North End soccer was struck a devastating blow with the death of ELCLFA and Parkridge-based Swaraj Football Club president Leonard Marillier on Saturday morning.

Marillier, aged 63, suffered a heart attack.

Fondly known as Nosie or Konaks, Marillier was a founder member of the Swaraj club, established in 1978.

He excelled at rugby at primary school and at athletics in the 100m, 200m and 800m distances.

A fitness fanatic, he spent hours training under his mentor, Latief Jogie.

In 1979 he became active in politics for the United Democratic Front and 11 years later he was appointed club manager of Swaraj FC.

He was elected club president in 1994 and had been at the helm ever since.

Marillier was also manager of the senior North End FA

squad that dominated the LFA regional competition in the 1990s, and served on the North End FA disciplinary committee.

As a community ambassador and leader, he contributed immensely towards community upliftment and played an instrumental role in his soccer club's rise to become one of the top amateur sides in North End and in the Buffalo City region.

He is survived by his wife, Jean and sons, Antonio and Roberto. — *DDC*

SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE PROSPECTIVE SERVICE PROVIDER FOR THE BUFFALO CITY CLEAN & GREEN CITY PROGRAMME 2025

BACKGROUND: The Border-Kel Chamber of Business (BKCOB), through its Waste and Environmental Programme and The Buffalo City Metro Municipality (BCM), owns and operates two permitted sanitary landfill sites, namely the Roundhill and King Williams Town landfill sites.

As an owner and operator of the two (2) Landfill Sites in accordance with permit requirements, BCM is required by the permit (license) to manage the pollution risks from the leachate and gaseous emissions from the operations of these sites. In addition, landfill operators are required to monitor and mitigate the environmental and occupational health & safety risks.

ALL PROJECT SUPPORT WILL BE FOR A DURATION OF 36 MONTHS AND OVERSIGHT.

PROJECT 1: POLLUTION MONITORING INFRASTRUCTURE

The scope of work for the pollution monitoring infrastructure entails the assessment, production of assessment report with recommendations as well as supervision of the contractors to be appointed for the implementation of the recommendations; these recommendations should cover the following aspects:

Training the waste management personnel at the two landfill sites on the internal audit and practice of conducting an audit.

3.3 Leachate pre-treatment

- » Use filtration technology for the pre-treatment of raw leachate.
- » This will include the use of gravel, coarse sand, and biochar (activated carbon).

3.4 Waste Exchange Platform

- » With the assistance of the National Cleaner Production Centre, develop a waste exchange platform for targeted waste streams that include used engine lubricating oil.
- » A waste exchange industrial symbiosis platform for various waste streams.
- » Knowledge of MSW generation sources for general and hazardous waste streams.
- » Pollution mitigation measures and improved responses in the event of emergency events such as injury, fire, and physical accident.
