The 90/10 Preferential Point System will be applied, where 90 points will be allocated for price and 10 points for specific goals. In order to Claim and be awarded points bidders must evidence that they belong to the targeted group specified.

The IDT Quantity Surveyor (QS) may where necessary conduct a risk assessment on all bidders who obtained a minimum threshold of 70% (i.e 70 points) in the functionality stage before the application of 90/10 pricing criteria. Bidders are requested to price each line item of the Bills of Quantities (BOQ). Should the bidder be deemed too risky to complete the project based on the QS's risk assessment report, they will be eliminated and not be considered for 90/10 pricing points evaluation criteria.

Only bidders who obtain 70% (70 points) minimum functionality threshold will be evaluated further.
