1.PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND

In response to the evolving landscape of financial reporting and governance, the Municipality has recognized the critical need for a comprehensive and accurate Fixed Asset Register (FAR). In alignment with the Generally Recognized Accounting Practice (GRAP) standards and Treasury Guidelines, the Municipality is seeking the services of a proficient and experienced professional service providers to assist the Municipality as in when basis for a period of 36 months.

1. OBJECTIVE

The primary objective is the meticulous preparation of a Fixed Asset Register that adheres to the stringent GRAP standards and Treasury Guidelines. This initiative is designed to enhance transparency, accountability, and compliance with regulatory frameworks governing municipal financial management. I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
