1	<p>Under the Technical Evaluation, under quality, it states:</p> <p>"Submission of a ISO 9001:2015 Quality certificate or Quality Management System (QMS)Documents submitted must be of the Bidder and not of a third party; e.g. Subcontractor"</p> <p>Does this mean ONLY manufacturers as eligible?</p> <p>Or what does it clearly mean? Or that we can get the ISO from the manufacturer with a support letter?</p>	<p>It is not only the manufacturers that are eligible and you do not have to get a manufacturer’s ISO certificate.</p> <p>The requirement further states “Documents submitted must be of the Bidder and not of a third party”. This means that the ISO certificate must be that of a company that is bidding, not any other company.</p> <p>The requirement also states “Quality Management System (QMS) may be submitted in the absence of the accreditation certificate (ISO 9001:2015 Quality Certificate)”. This means that you can submit a QMS should you not have the ISO certificate.</p>
2	<p>We have picked up some discrepancy on the price sheet and NEC prices</p> <p>The pricing sheet has 7 items and the NEC has 9 items</p> <p>Please assist by updating the correct one</p>	<p>Use the one on the RFP document, that is the correct one. Annexure A was for bidders to see the full descriptions.</p>
3	<p>I would like to check what we need to write on the space designed for company stamps if the company doesn't have a stamp</p> <p>Is it ok to only put the designated personnel to innitalize on that space</p>	<p>If your company does not have a stamp, an initial by the authorized person will suffice.</p>
