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5. SPECIFICATIONS OF GOODS REQUIRED

1. Background

uMngeni-Uthukela Water is requiring services for the supply and delivery of various size gabion baskets, reno matrasses and geotextioe fabric to be used at various river and stream crossing along the pipeline routes of Umngeni- Uthukela Water within the inland region/UMgungundlovu District area of Supply.

2. Description of goods/ services required

The scope involves the supply and delivery of:

- 3X1X 1 gabion baskets
- 2X1X1 gabion baskets
- 3X 1 X 0.5 m gabion baskets
- 2 X 1 X 0.5 m gabion baskets
- 3 X 1 X 0.3 m reno mattresses
- 2 X 1 X 0.3 m reno mattresses
- 6 X 2X 0.17 m reno mattresses
- Geotextile fabric
- Binding and lacing wire

4. Technical Specifications

Gabions baskets manufactured to SANS 1580 with hexagonal woven wire Mesh Type 80, commonly referred to as double twist wire mesh. The steel wire used in the manufacture of Gabions is 2.7*mm in diameter to SANS 675 and is heavily galvanized to class A with zinc or zinc alloy (Galfan Zn 95Al5) coated wire according to SANS 1580 and has a tensile strength between 350-575N/mm2. If required, a Polymer coating is extruded over the galvanised wire to provide added protection for use in aggressive environments where corrosion is present. The two types of Polymer coatings available are, PVC coating to SANS 1580 which is available in grey or tan and has a nominal thickness of 0,5mm and PA6 Nylon coating to EN 10245-5 which comes in black and has a nominal thickness of 0,4mm.

Heavy Duty Reno mattresses are to be manufactured to SANS 1580 with hexagonal woven wire Mesh Type 60, commonly referred to as double twist wire mesh. The steel wire used during the manufacture of the mattress must be 2.7mmdiameter to SANS 675 and is heavily zinc or zinc alloy (Galfan Zn95Al5) coated, Class A as per SANS 1580 and has a tensile strength between 350-575N/mm2. If required, a Polymer coating of PVC orPA6 nylon is extruded over the galvanised wire to provide added protection for use in aggressive environments where



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corrosion is present. The two types of Polymer coatings available are, PVC coating to SANS 1580 which is available in grey or tan and has a nominal thickness of 0,5 mm and PA6 Nylon coating to EN 10245-5 which comes in black and has a nominal thickness of 0,4mm. Complete with partitions at 1m centers in both directions.

Geotextile fabric (bidim) non-woven 100% continuous polyester filaments double needle punched with a minimum 6.5kn/m energy absorption

Mac Mat-R or similar is a three-dimensional erosion control mat manufactured from entangled polypropylene mono-filaments. MacMat-R is reinforced with gabion or double-twist wire mesh. This unique combination marries the excellent anti-erosion properties of the three-dimensional MacMat and geomat with the tensile properties of the reinforcement, and can therefore be used for long-term root reinforcement, erosion control, re-vegetation, in hydraulic applications and, when used with soil nails and shotcrete, for slope stabilisation.

Mac Mat-R is suitable for light hydraulic protection where the flow velocity does not exceed to 1.5m/s over a period of maximum 60 hours where vegetation is established. MacMat-R can also be used in combination with soil nailing for erosion control of the slope to enhance vegetation growth (especially when hydro-seeded), or with shotcrete when the face is not homogenous and requires sharp contour cover, ensuring constant thickness.

Lacing wire is used to assemble and interconnect empty units, to close and secure stone filled units and for internal stiffeners. Lacing wire should be supplied in coils. All lacing wire is Class A zinc coated it should be PVC coated gabions, PVC coated.

3.1.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:
