DESCRIPTION OF A TENDER

TERMS OF REFERENCE

- These tender forms an integral part of the agreement between Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife and the awarded service provider.
- The advertising sign or structure must be approved in terms of the National Building Regulations, Building Bylaws and any other relevant Biodiversity Conservation prescripts.. Furthermore, the structure also requires the approval of all relevant service units within Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife prior to any work being carried out on site.
- The rights granted herein permit the erection and management of the advertising billboard structure within Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife premises as specified.
- The structure to be designed should be aesthetically pleasing to maintain the architectural integrity of the precinct and also provide Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife information.
- Monthly routine maintenance inspections must be carried out to ensure that the advertising sign/ structure remain in a good state of repair and proper working condition at all times.
- Intermediate maintenance as required must be attended to with minimum delay, with time frames provided for attendance.
- The design shall incorporate every reasonable precaution and provision for the safety of all those concerned in the operation including the safety of the general public and shall be in compliance with all Occupational Health and Safety requirements.
- The maintenance of all signs and/or structures erected in terms of this tender will remain the responsibility of the service provider.

- ii) The preference points claimed are in accordance with the General Conditions as indicated in paragraph 1 of this form.
- iii) In the event of a contract being awarded as a result of points claimed as shown in paragraphs 1.4 and 6.1, the contractor may be required to furnish documentary proof to the satisfaction of the purchaser that the claims are correct.
- iv) If the B-BBEE status level of contributor has been claimed or obtained on a fraudulent basis or any of the conditions of contract have not been fulfilled, the purchaser may, in addition to any other remedy it may have
 - (a) disqualify the person from the bidding process.
 - (b) recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct.
 - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of

having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation.

- (d) recommend that the bidder or contractor, its shareholders, and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted by the National Treasury from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the *audi alteram partem* (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
- (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution.
