### 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

Quotation for the supply, delivery and offloading of nursery growth media and plant nutrients, plant containers and equipment for Nursery Operations as and when required for a period of 1 year. These are the Nurseries growth media and plant nutrients, plant containers and equipment required for the nursery over the year for plant production.

### 2. BACKGROUND

Nursery Operations uses various growth media and plant containers for the propagation and cultivation of various plants. These plants are grown by Nursery Operations and when the plants have grown, they are then planted in the tourist parks, urban parks, traffic islands and as street trees.

The growth media and plant containers are required by Nursery Operations of the Environmental Management and Parks Division.

The benefiting Divisions are Environmental Management and Parks, Community Services and Agriculture and Rural Development.

The ornamental plants produced will be planted in parks, public open spaces and streetscapes and therefore improve on the beautification of the City. The vegetable seedlings produced are supplied to the Agriculture and Rural Development Division, for food production programs.

The city as a whole will benefit as a beautiful, green city is known to attract tourists and indirectly contribute to the economy of the city.

### 3. PROJECT SCOPE AND DELIVERABLES

## The following nursery growth media, plant containers and equipment are required:

### ITEM 1: VARIOUS GROWTH MEDIA AND PLANT NUTRIENTS

The following requirements must be met:

- The items must be free from Weeds, insects and disease.
- None of the declared weeds and invaders as listed in the Conservation of Agricultural Resources Act, 1983 (Act no 43 of 1983) and its amendments.

- All plastic planting bags and sheeting are to be the nursery's standard colour black.
- All plastic bags and containers must be manufactured from Virgin plastic and UV treated.
- NO regran (RECYCLED) plastic will be accepted. The bidder must guarantee this with their supplier and all plastic bags and plastic sheeting must be replaced at their cost.
- The plastic must comply with the minimum micron thickness required. It may be thicker but not thinner.

• All containers must be 100% manufactured in South Africa.

### 4.3 STAGE 3: PREFERENTIAL POINT SYSTEM

The preferential points to be used will be the 80/20 points system in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2022.

- 80 points for price
- 20 points for specific goals

- Bidders are required to submit supporting documents for their bids to claim the specific goal points.
- Non-compliance with specific goals will not lead to disqualification but bidders will not be allocated specific goal points. Bidders will score points out of 80 for price only and zero (0) points out of 20 for specific goals.
- Cot shall act against any bidder or person when it detects that the specific goals were claimed or obtained on a fraudulent basis.

### CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION
