#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

- 1. SAQA seeks to appoint a Service Provider to provide Maintenance and Support of their two UPSs with the following specifications:
  - (a) 2 X30KVA UPS System Durapower DP3000 Battery
    - true online double conversion transformer-based UPS with both static and manual bypass facility
  - (b) Battery specifications 60 x CSB GP12650 sealed maintenance free battery packs
- 2. The Services Provider shall have the following responsibilities, including but not limited to:
- 2.1 Preventative maintenance servicing will consist of the following:
- 2.1.1 Checking and if necessary, adjusting all electronic control circuits.
- 2.1.2 Checking and if necessary, adjusting all electronic display circuits.
- 2.1.3 Control checks, visual inspections on power components, IGBT power packs, capacitors, transformers, pc boards and ventilations fans.
- 2.1.4 Cleaning of equipment.
- 2.1.5 Checking of battery connections for tightness and cleaning of corrosion if required.
- 2.1.6 Checking of all battery float voltages.
- 2.1.7 Load testing of battery packs via customer load.
- 2.1.8 Advice of any parts found defectively and quote to replace.
- 2.1.9 Supply a detailed UPS service test report with all reordered results to the client.



- (b) "**B-BBEE** status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status of an entity in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (d) "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (e) "EME" means an Exempted Micro Enterprise in terms of a code of good practice on black economic empowerment issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- (f) "functionality" means the ability of a tenderer to provide goods or services in accordance with specifications as set out in the tender documents.
- (g) "prices" includes all applicable taxes less all unconditional discounts;

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#### CERTIFICATE OF INDEPENDENT BID DETERMINATION

- 1 This Standard Bidding Document (SBD) must form part of all bids<sup>1</sup> invited.
