TERMS OF REFERENCE:

Makhuduthamaga Municipality is sourcing for Civil litigation law firm for local governments to advise and manage legal disputes, handle court proceedings, and draft legal documents to protect the council and its institution and employees from liability and ensure compliance with the law. Duties include representing the local authority in civil matters like, property disputes, and contract breaches; advising on the legality of new policies; conducting thorough legal research; and managing all aspects of court cases, from initial pleadings to final adjudication or settlement.

Key Duties

Legal Advice and Representation:

Provide expert legal advice to council staff and officials on a wide range of matters, including property law, employment law, social services, and contract disputes.

Litigation Management:

Handle all aspects of civil court cases, including:

• **Drafting and Filing Documents**: Prepare and file necessary legal documents such as lawsuits, complaints, and counterclaims on behalf of the local authority.

Discovery Process

Conduct thorough investigations, gather evidence, interview witnesses, and manage the discovery process, including responding to requests for documents and information.

Court Proceedings

 Argue cases in court, present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, and represent the local government's interests in any hearings or trials.
