SECTION 1: SPECIFICATIONS

We have 2 water systems on site.

One system is a fresh water system, ie. The water for the system comes from Johannesburg Water as well as the make-up water.

The other system is a De-lonized water system, the make-up water also comes from Johannesburg water.

We also have 2 chiller units, The Daikin as well as the Carrier Chiller unit. Both the Daikin and the Carrier Chiller cools down the fresh water system.

The Daikin is the first chiller to switch on in the cooling process and the Carrier switches in if the Daikin cannot maintain the temperature.

This water been chilled by the 2 Chiller units need to be treated in order to prevent corrosion and the formation of bacteria in the chiller units and as well as the complete water system.

This cold water, in turn, cools down the water in the Di-lonizing water system, thus cooling down the equipment in our plant. The De-lonizing water is created by means of a special resin which chemically polishes the water to form di-water.
