







TENDER EVALUATION PROCESS

Stage 2 : Technical Evaluations

- Each region will be evaluated on its separate technical evaluation sheet, bidders must go through each technical evaluation to understand the requirements for their region/s of interest.
- The minimum qualifying threshold is **70 points** for each regional technical evaluation.

TENDER EVALUATION PROCESS

Stage 3 : Objective Criteria

Transnet reserves the right to award the business to the highest scoring bidder/s unless objective criteria justify the award to another bidder. The objective criteria Transnet may apply in this bid process include:

- TPT will conduct site visits per region to verify the bidder's compliance to the scope of works and the quality standards of the tyre's to be supplied, please refer to **Annexure H** for the checklist that will be utilised during these site visit.
