1. INTRODUCTION TO NATIONAL RESEARCH FOUNDATION AND SARAO

INTRODUCTION TO THE NRF

The National Research Foundation Act as amended, Act 19 of 2018, establishes the National Research Foundation (“NRF”) as the juristic legal entity that will contract with the awarded bidder. Please visit the NRF website (<https://www.nrf.ac.za>) for more information.

BACKGROUND TO SARAO

The South African Radio Astronomy Observatory (SARAO) is the National Research Foundation’s National Facility incorporating South Africa’s radio astronomy instruments and programmes such as the MeerKAT and KAT-7 telescopes in the Karoo in the Northern Cape, the Hartebeesthoek Radio Astronomy Observatory (HartRAO) in Gauteng, the African Very Long Baseline Interferometry (AVN) programme in nine African countries as well as the associated human capital development and commercialisation endeavours. More information about SARAO is available from www.sarao.ac.za. More information about the international SKA project is available from www.skatelescope.org.

The Klerefontein Support Base provides the necessary facilities and infrastructure for the MeerKat and SKA radio instruments, located approximately 85km away from the site and 12kms from Carnarvon in the Northern Cape. Due to the expansion of the MeerKAT Project and the construction initiation of the SKA1-MID project, additional developments will be required at the Klerefontein Support Base. Detailed survey information is required to support the detailed design and construction of the envisaged developments at Klerefontein.

2. SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS

SARAO requires a competent service provider to perform a topographical survey at the SARAO Klerefontein Support Base, approximately 17km outside the town of Carnarvon. Klerefontein is located in the Kareeberg Local Municipality which is in Pixley ka Seme District Municipality in the Northern Cape. [GPS Coordinates 30°58'09.8"S 21°58'55.1"E]

2.1 DELIVERABLES/ REQUIREMENTS

A quotation will be required for rendering of topographical surveyor services, based on the extent of services indicated below (item 2.1.1). The quotation required must respond in detail to the listed points below:

- Resources allocated, including hours allocated, to undertake site surveying

- Resources allocated, including hours allocated, to undertake desktop work
- Based on these available resources, highlighted below, a high-level programme is required.

2.1.1. Extent of services

- 2.1.1.1. Survey to be based on WGS84 and MSL of the area as shown on the attached locality site plan that is currently available (Klerefontein Support Base Survey kmz file - Google earth document). Note that the survey must include the full width of all adjacent road reserves and embankments (where applicable).
- 2.1.1.2. The street addresses of all cadastral even within the precinct must be indicated and including outside peripheral areas, together with the 'north' point.
- 2.1.1.3. A digital terrain model must be taken at not more than 12m spacing to give a contour interval of 0.5m.
- 2.1.1.4. All site boundaries, fence lines, existing structures, streams/watercourses, solar panels, services, trees (trunk and crown) and all other features must be surveyed.
- 2.1.1.5. All visible services must be investigated and measured giving all:
 - Incoming and outgoing invert levels and pipe sizes at each manhole, surveyor to provide equipment and manpower to open and clean existing manholes, where required to obtain invert levels.
 - Building and tank outlines including internal and external levels.
 - All dams to be surveyed for levels at top of banks and bottom of dam banks at 5m intervals including invert levels of all inlet and outlets.
 - Pipe alignments (sewer/ storm water) together with direction of flows.
 - This must include conservancy/septic tanks, together with associated plan dimensions/ extents.
 - All water points (taps, valves, markers, boreholes, header tanks, water meters, etc.). Where possible/ applicable, sizes and routes must be shown.
 - Culvert sizes and types must be indicated on plan together with outfall structure types. These must include all levels of this infrastructure.
- 2.1.1.6. All streets, road markings, verge positions up to edge of road with all found services up to and including edge of road and levels on both top and bottom of kerbs must be provided.
- 2.1.1.7. The survey must show the outline of all adjacent buildings. Note: where no adjacent buildings exist, the survey must extend to cover KLF Agreement area and extended

- survey area ARC as indicated on the Klerefontein Support Base Survey kmz file (Google earth document).
- 2.1.1.8. Cadastral data must be investigated and plotted showing all sub divisions and servitudes (including the existing servitudes). SG diagrams must also be made available to the Client.
 - 2.1.1.9. The 1:100 and 1:50 year floodlines of existing watercourses must also be shown (where applicable). Where streams/ watercourses do exist, the survey must extend at least 25m on either side of the centre line of said stream/ watercourse and the survey must also extend 50m upstream and downstream of the site boundary edges.
 - 2.1.1.10. All existing buildings (formal and informal) must be surveyed and clearly referenced on the overall survey site plan. The top of slab levels for all concrete surface beds, walkways, aprons and concrete steps to be included.
 - 2.1.1.11. Survey and plotting onto a drawing of existing cables, fiber optic cables, telephone poles, sleeves and telephone take-off points including telephone manholes, sleeves and overhead/underground telephone cables.
 - 2.1.1.12. Survey and plotting onto a drawing of all overhead power lines, overhead/ underground electrical cables, sleeves, light poles, electrical manholes, Mini-Subs and Sub-Stations.
 - 2.1.1.13. The surveyor to peg electrical and electronic cable routes (where applicable).
 - 2.1.1.14. The position and description of the closest bulk service 'take-off' point and route (sewer, water, stormwater, and electricity) must be indicated.
 - 2.1.1.15. Information must be supplied in 'dxf', 'dwg' and 'tot' format, including 2 colour hard copies of all drawings.

 - (d) recommend that the bidder or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted by the National Treasury from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the Audi alteram partem (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
 - (e) Forward the matter for criminal prosecution.
