Project Name:	PANEL OF TWO SERVICE PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE FULL OCCUPATIONAL MEDICAL SURVEILLANCE TO MOQHAKA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY FOR PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS AS AND WHEN NEEDED.
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Guideline for Terms of reference

This tender is for the appointment of a panel of two service providers to provide full occupational medical surveillance to Moqhaka Local Municipality for period of three (3) years as and when needed.

A. Background

Moqhaka Local Municipality requires a full occupational medical surveillance for employees as and when necessary.

B. Scope of Work / Terms of Reference

Bill of Quantities / Pricing Schedule.

Tender prices to be fixed for the first twelve (12) months and only annual escalation will be provided for as per the Service Level Agreement (SLA).

C. Panel

In this panel, the municipality will appoint a maximum of 2 service providers who scored the highest points scored in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy of Moqhaka Local Municipality.

D. Sourcing of Quotations

Quotations will be requested only from the service providers appointed on the panel to ensure all service providers appointed on the panel have an opportunity of being selected during the contract period.

Should the service providers on the panel not be in a position to provide the required service within the desired timeframes, the municipality will deem it necessary to invite quotations outside the appointed panel.

The municipality will derive a flat rate from the prices submitted by the successful bidders. This flat rate will be offered to the bidders through a negotiation process. This will assist the municipality with a fair and equitable process of rotation. This will also prohibit the municipality from paying more for the same service between service providers on the panel.

E. Performance Management

In terms of Section 116 (2) of the MFMA, the municipality is required by Law to monitor the performance of service providers on a monthly basis in line with the performance areas as stipulated in the Service Level Agreement (SLA). The monitoring of panels will be done as and when their services are utilised.

F. Preferential Points System

Indicate whether the tender will be evaluated in terms of 80/20 below a 50 million and 90/10 above 50 million.

80/20

A maximum of 20 points (80/20 preference points system), will be allocated for specific goals. The maximum points for these goals are as follows:

- Locality of Supplier – 15 Points
- Youth Ownership of Company (Youth is 35 years and younger) - 5 Points

These goals are specified in MBD6.1 in terms of the PPR2022.
