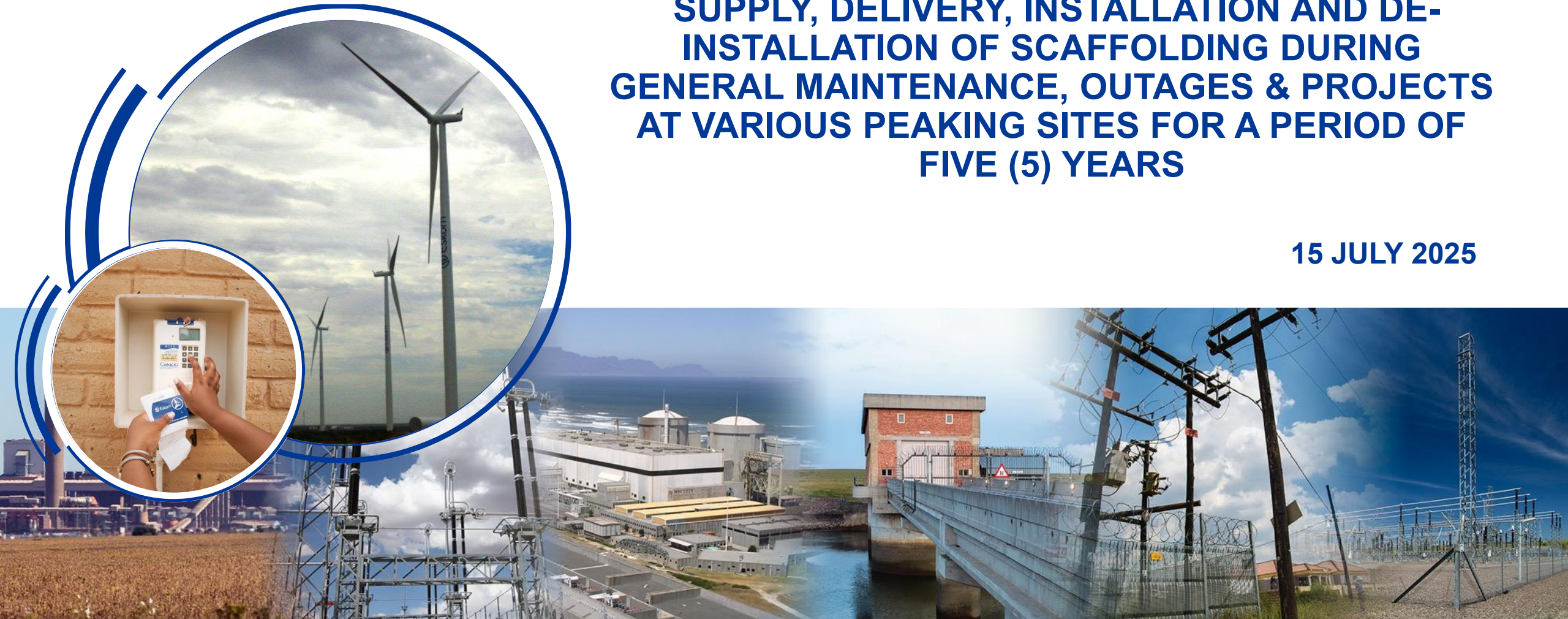

Only those Tenderers who:

- Are Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) contractor grading of **7SL** or higher or capable of being so registered within twenty-one (21) working days from the closing date for submission of tenders will have their tender offers evaluated

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that :

- Every member of the Joint venture (JV) is registered with the CIDB;
- The lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **6SL** class of construction work
- The combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the CIDB regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a or **7SL**

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- The lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **6SL** class of construction work
- The combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the CIDB regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered for a or **7SL**

- The contract maybe split based on logistical aspects such as regions as this project is for different Peaking Sites.
