# VALIDITY PERIOD

The tender shall remain valid for a period of **180 days from the date of closing of the tender**. Rand Water reserves the right to extend the validity period if required.

# PRE-QUALIFIERS...

1. Fully completed and signed Form of Offer.
2. Letter of Good Standing from the Department of Labour or an Accredited Institution.
3. The use of correction fluid or any other similar substance to make corrections is not permitted.
4. Bidder must subcontract a minimum of 30% of the value of the contract (if above R30 million) to an **EME/QSE** that is a minimum 51% black owned.

*The following evidence must be submitted:*

- *A signed Subcontracting agreement stipulating the percentage to be subcontracted and the specialized categories (**Scope of work being subcontracted**)*
- CSD report/s for Subcontractor/s.
- Proof of B-BBEE status for Subcontractor/s
- Where CIDB related works are subcontracted, each Subcontractor must also be registered with the appropriate CIDB grading in accordance with the value of the work to be undertaken by that Subcontractor.

**Where the CIDB requirement for subcontracted work is not met, this pre-qualifier has not been met.**



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# PRE-QUALIFIERS...

5. Bidders must be registered with the CIDB, or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the CIDB grading of this bid; in accordance with the CIDB prescripts.

6. Fully completed and signed Local Content Declaration Forms for each of the designated sectors as provided herein and minimum stipulated thresholds for this bid, as outlined (Page 27-29).

- **100% minimum threshold for local production and content for the steel value added products and components as stipulated on page 28** or Exemption from the Minister of Finance in the case of non-compliance to the Local Content threshold.
- **70% minimum threshold for local production and content for Valves products and Actuators as stipulated on page 28** or Exemption from the Minister of Finance in the case of non-compliance to the Local Content threshold.

7. Submission of Socio-Economic Development (SED) proposal in accordance with Rand Water's requirements and targets in T2.2.9 and the signing of the SED schedule in its entirety

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# SCOPE OF WORK...

The works consist of two packages as follows:

## Package 1: Construction of the Stockpile Area

- Construction of the stock pile area as per the design
- Repair to all damaged roads, drying bed wall and decanting towers
- Closure of stockpile area
- Prepare a methodology for removal of WTR
- Removal of WTR residue to the stock pile area

# SCOPE OF WORK...

## Package 2: Rehabilitation of drying beds...

- Site establishment
- Identify and mark the existing services e.g. pipeline work, chambers and WTR spray infrastructure
- Refurbish/replace all secondary WTR reticulation network and its respective sprayers, if necessary, to be determined by the Engineer's representative on site..
- Clear and dispose of all vegetation within the identified drying beds
- Excavate sludge, ready to be hauled away from the affected drying beds
- Refurbish drying beds walls as identified by Contractor and approved by resident Engineer, if necessary, to be determined by the Engineer's representative on site.

# SCOPE OF WORK

## Package 2: Rehabilitation of drying beds

Reinstatement of access roads between beds, if necessary, to be determined by the Engineer's representative on site.

Reinstatement of decanting towers, including installation of decanting slates and access bridge, if necessary, to be determined by the Engineer's representative on site.

Load of haul of sludge to designated areas within the Panfontein Sludge Disposal Site

General levelling of all spoiled sites

Site de-establishment

# COMMERCIAL CONTINUED: EVALUATION PROCESS...

**Rand Water conducts a two stage evaluation process for all bids, intending to provide services or goods to the organization as follows:**

**Being Technical/Functionality evaluation and the price and preference**

**1. Functionality evaluation (Technical capabilities)** All bids evaluated at this stage must achieve a minimum of 70% scoring, **a score below 70 % a supplier will not be considered to the second stage of the evaluation(price and preference).**The

**Technical Evaluation will be based on:**

- a) **Record of Previous Experience relevant to the current scope/ work (with contactable client ref.)**
- b) **Overall Performance on Previous Work**
- c) **Quality Management Systems**
- d) **Human Resource Capacity**
- e) **Equipment Resource Capacity**



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# COMMERCIAL CONTINUED: EVALUATION PROCESS

- a) **Equipment Resource Capacity**
- b) **Risk Introduced by Bid Qualifications**
- c) **Project Risk Management**
- d) **Detailed Project Programme**
- e) **Method Statement**
- f) **SHERQ**

- Rand Water shall then apply the objective criteria in accordance with the PPPFA that will determine the evaluation outcome
- Part of the functionality evaluation Rand Water also uses a **Financial Tolerance Range for price and the range for this bid is -20% to 20%**.

**2. Price and Preferential point system.** The award is then based on the preferential point system **90/10 point system**.

- In addition to the above **Due Diligence** on the supplier may also be conducted.



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# RETURNABLE DOCUMENTS

- Pay attention to all returnable under T Section and ensure that they appropriately returned.
- Non-submission of any item listed only under the column “Required for Bid Evaluation” may result in the bid being rejected by the Employer.
