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SCOPE OF WORK:

This work is for a cathodic protection condition survey of the Komati Water Scheme, Matla to Kriel pipeline and Kendal Kusile pipeline systems. The status of the existing systems shall be evaluated, and any additional or remedial measures shall be identified to adequately protect the pipeline systems. Current constraints and problems shall be identified and taken into consideration including the basic design of certain parts of the system in order to mitigate vandalism of equipment.

The work will be completed in 2 phases:

Phase 1:

Will include a survey of the existing cathodic protection (CP) systems of the KWS, Matla Kriel and Kendal Kusile systems.

- Inspection and testing of all Transformer Rectification Units (TRUs), Forced Drainage Units (FDUs) and Natural Drainage Units (NDUs).
- Physical inspection of anode ground beds for signs of external damage or interference
- Measurement of ground bed resistance for comparison against previous values to determine deterioration and current state.
- Measurement of spot potentials at all test points
- Stray current recordings at 5km intervals
- Inspection and insulation testing of insulating flanges
- Inspection and testing of cross and continuity bonds
- Recording of current flow at foreign service crossings
- Assessment of vandalism on the CP system equipment
- Preparation of an assessment report that will provide detailed information on the current state of the CP systems. The report will be used and enable the employer to make informed decisions on the future of the CP systems. The consultant will also use this information for providing Phase 2.

Estimated duration : 3 months

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Phase 2:

Includes an assessment of the vandalism problems on the systems and the basic design of possible changes to the systems to mitigate the vandalism problem.

- A detailed investigation and report into possible design changes of the CP systems to mitigate the current vandalism problem. This shall include discussions with the employer's personnel on site and head office.
- Basic design of the proposed changes and repairs on the CP systems. This should include basic drawings and diagrams, technical information, cost estimates all included in a report.
- Specification document that could be used by the employer to go to the market in order procure and implement the required changes.
