All work must follow Eskom's permit-to-work procedures and other SHE procedures on site.

Personnel must be certified and experienced in the provision of Routine And Ad Hoc Condition Monitoring Service at the power station. 		2. Basis of Labour Rates								
		2.1 The labour rates shall be fully inclusive of all costs associated with the employment of personnel, including but not limited to:								
		Basic wages and salaries; Allowances (including travel, subsistence, living away from home, or other applicable allowances); Statutory contributions such as PAYE, UIF, SDL, and pension/provident fund contributions; All insurances required by law or the Contract, including Workmen's Compensation and Public Liability insurance; Provision of standard tools and equipment normally associated with the trade or occupation; Overheads, profit, supervision, and administration; and All other incidental expenses necessary for the proper execution of the Services.  2.2 The labour rates shall be exclusive of Value Added Tax (VAT), which shall be added separately in accordance with the requirements of the tender form.								
		2.3 The rates shall be based on a normal working day of eight (8) hours, unless otherwise stated in the Scope.								
		2.4 Overtime rates, where applicable, shall be stated separately and shall be calculated based on the relevant statutory or negotiated wage agreements.								
		3. Classification of Labour

		7.2 Thereafter, adjustments to rates may be made in accordance with the price adjustment formula or mechanism stated in the Contract Data, typically linked to officially published indices such as the Consumer Price Index (CPI) or the Building and Construction Materials Index.								
		8. Safety and Compliance								
		8.1 The tenderer shall include in all labour rates for compliance with all safety, health, and environmental requirements as specified in the Scope and in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations.								
		8.2 The Service Provider shall provide all necessary Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for their employees at their own cost.								
		9. Temporary Works and Tools								
		9.1 The cost of all temporary works, hand tools, and minor plant required by each labour category shall be included in the labour rates.
