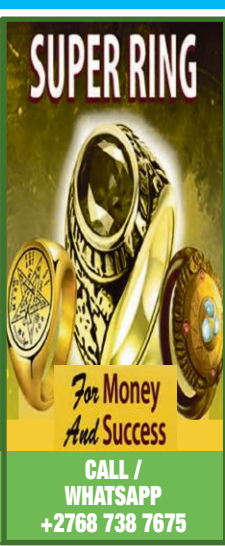

The contract was amended with an additional amount of R1 252 326.77 which is 60% increase of the original contract.
