The following information is furnished in addition to the tender documents issued in respect of the abovementioned work. There are three (3) items that this addendum seeks to address (Revised CIDB grading levels for each type of fence/site, Additional Compulsory Site Visit for Section 2 Port of Ngqura Hot Dipped Galvanized Mesh Fencing ONLY and the Extension of the closing date).

1. Revised CIDB Grading level for each type of fence/site

1.1. SECTION 1 COEGA KOP QUARRY - CONCRETE FENCE

THE CIDB GRADING LEVEL AND CLASS OF WORKS REMAINS UNCHANGED AS ORIGINALLY ADVERTISED AT 7SQ

Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, designation of **7SQ or higher** class of construction work, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated. The most up to date information is always available on the CIDB website. As a result, Transnet National Ports Authority will check the status of registered contractors on the website and not rely on contractor registration certificates submitted.

1.2. SECTION 2 PORT OF NGQURA – HOT DIPPED GALVANIZED MESH FENCE THE CIDB GRADING LEVEL AND CLASS OF WORKS IS CHANGED FROM 7SQ TO 6SQ

Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, designation of **6SQ or higher** class of construction work, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated. The most up to date information is always available on the CIDB website. As a result, Transnet National Ports Authority will check the status of registered contractors on the website and not rely on contractor registration certificates submitted.



1.3. TENDERING FOR BOTH SECTIONS – BOTH TYPE OF FENCES (CONCRETE AND HOT DIPPED GALVANIZED MESH FENCE)

THE CIDB GRADING LEVEL AND CLASS OF WORKS REMAINS UNCHANGED AS ORIGINALLY ADVERTISED AT 7SO

Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, designation of **7SQ or higher** class of construction work, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.  ADDITIONAL COMPULSORY SITE VISIT FOR SECTION 2 PORT OF NGQURA FOR HOT DIPPED GALVANISED MESH FENCE ONLY – as the affected site regarding the CIDB grading level

ANY TENDERER THAT HAS ATTENDED THE COMPULSORY SITE VISIT ON THE 12TH OF JUNE 2025 DO NOT NEED TO ATTEND THE ADDITIONAL COMPULSORY SITE VISIT. THE ADDITIONAL COMPULSORY SITE VISIT IS MEANT FOR ANY POTENTIAL TENDERERS THAT INTENDS TO TENDER ONLY FOR SECTION 2 PORT OF NGQURA — HOT DIPPED GALVANIZED MESH FENCE DUE TO THE CIDB GRADING LEVEL 6SQ CHANGE

2.1. COMPULSORY SITE VISIT DETAILS (Non-attendance will disqualify tenderer for Section 2 Port of Ngqura – Hot Dipped Galvanized Mesh Fence Only)

Site walk/visit will take place on the 24th of June 2025 in the following order: All potential tenderers to assemble at the Port of Ngqura, eMendi Building, Lower Ground, Elwandle Boardroom, Port Elizabeth at 8h30am. The order of visiting the sites will be as follows:

Firstly, to view the free issue material at Port of Ngqura, eMendi Building, Lower Ground, Elwandle Boardroom, Port Elizabeth, the successful tenderer will also analyze the free issue material in detail upon award for utilization

Secondly, to the Eastern Breakwater,

Thirdly, to the Multi-purpose Terminal (including C100), and

Fourth and lastly, to the Sand Bypass.



2.2. ATTENDANCE OF COMPULSORY SITE VISIT

It is preferable that the authorized representative/s of the tendering entity or a representative/s of a tendering entity that intends to form a Joint Venture (JV) allow any but not limited to the following three (3) key personnel, Construction Manager, Quality Officer, Civil Engineer and the tendering entity's supplier of fencing (hot dipped galvanized wire mesh) to attend the COMPULSORY site visit where they will enquire on the drawings, site related questions to ensure the tendering entity quotes accurately for Section 2 Port of Ngqura part of the scope of work.

2.3. LOGISTICS OF ATTENDING COMPULSORY SITE VISIT

- Tenderers to provide own transportation and accommodation (if required).
- It is compulsory for tenderers to wear safety shoes/boots, reflective visibility vests.
- Tenderers are requested to bring life jackets in the event where a tenderer wishes to view the site/s close to water boundaries.
- Tenderers without the recommended Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
 will not be allowed on the site walk/visit.
- Tenderers and their employees, visitors, clients, and customers entering Transnet
 Offices, Depots, Workshops and Stores will have to undergo breathalyser testing.
- All forms of firearms are prohibited on Transnet properties and premises.
- The relevant people attending the meeting must ensure that their identity documents, passports, or drivers' licenses are in their possession for inspection at the access control gates.
- Certificate of Attendance in the form set out in the Returnable Schedule T2.2-01 hereto
 must be completed and submitted with your Tender as proof of attendance is required
 for a compulsory site visit. An attendance register will be completed for the compulsory
 site visit and used to issue the Returnable Schedule T2.2-01 Certificate of Attendance
 signed by the Employer's Representative at the end of the compulsory site visit
 Tenderers failing to attend the compulsory site visit will be disqualified for Section 2
 Port of Ngqura Hot Dipped Galvanized Mesh Fence only.

3. EXTENDED CLOSING DATE

- 3.1. Tender Closing date has been extended from **30 JUNE 2025** at 15h00 to **04 JULY 2025** at 15h00.
- 3.2. Tenderers must ensure that bids are uploaded timeously onto system. As general rule, if a bid is late, it will not be accepted for consideration.



All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.

All Tenderers are hereby requested to sign this addendum as an acknowledgement and consent to this addendum and return it as a returnable together with their proposal documents.
