

C.2.1.4.3 Minimum score for functionality

In order to be considered for a contract in terms of this tender, tenderers must achieve the minimum score for functionality as stated below.

The description of the functionality criteria and the maximum possible score for each is shown in the table below. The score achieved for functionality will be the sum of the scores achieved, in the evaluation process, for the individual criteria.

Description of functionality criteria	Maximum possible score
Qualifications and demonstrated experience of the key staff in relation to the scope of work;	30
Track Record of Equipment	10
Demonstrated Experience of Tenderer	10
Maintenance and Service Department in South Africa	10
Maximum possible score for Functionality	60

The minimum score for functionality is **36**. Tenderers that fail to achieve the minimum score for functionality will be declared as non-responsive.

Where the entity tendering is a Joint Venture the tender must be accompanied by a statement describing exactly what aspects of the work will be undertaken by each party to the joint venture (appended to Schedule 3, Part T2.2: Returnable Schedules). **All relevant key personnel, being the tenderer, the OEM as well as the subcontractors, will be evaluated based on functionality.**

Tenderers shall ensure that all relevant information has been submitted with the tender offer in the prescribed format to ensure optimal scoring of functionality points for each Evaluation Criteria. Failure to provide all information **IN THIS TENDER SUBMISSION** could result in the tenderer not being able to achieve the specified minimum scoring.

A more detailed explanation of the functionality criteria is given below :

C.2.1.4.3.1 Key personnel

In order to be considered for an appointment in terms of this tender, the tenderer must have the following key personnel in its permanent employment at the close of tender. Alternatively, a signed undertaking from a specialist company having the required personnel, stating that they will undertake the necessary work on behalf of the tenderer in terms of a sub-contractor agreement, will be acceptable. Such undertaking must be attached to **Schedule 12**, Part T2.2: Returnable Schedules.

Key personnel will be expected to operate out of the local office, as the exigencies of this project require. The experience required shall be in the field of expertise required for the scope of the work of this tender.
