## INVITATION FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS TO SUPPLY AND DELIVER STAFF UNIFORMS AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE CLOTHING FOR uMGUNGUNDLOVU DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY

## **TENDER NO. 14/2023**

The uMgungundlovu District Municipality seeks to appointment professional service providers to supply and deliver staff uniforms and protective clothing for the Office Attendants, Meter Readers, Stores Unit, Technical Unit, Disaster Unit, Environmental Health Unit and Water & Sanitation staff of the uMgungundlovu District Municipality for a period of three (3) years commencing from the date of award ending 2026.

If tenders are collected, a non-refundable tender deposit of R150.00 is payable to the uMgungundlovu District Municipality. A Compulsory Briefing Session will be held on **27 SEPTEMBER 2023 at 14h00**, at the uMgungundlovu District Municipality, Council Chambers, 242 Langalibalele Street, Pietermaritzburg. Non-attendance at the Compulsory Briefing Session will render any submission invalid.

Tender submissions must be properly bound and must be placed in the tender box situated on the ground floor of the uMgungundlovu District Municipality, 242 Langalibalele Street, Pietermaritzburg, before 12h00 on **11 OCTOBER 2023**, in a sealed envelope which is clearly marked with the Tender Number and Tender Description. Late quotations or Tenders received by way of Facsimile or E-Mail will under no circumstances be considered.

All eligibility criteria must be furnished accordingly, where mandatory or applicable. Tenderers will thereafter be evaluated in terms of functionality before being evaluated on price and preference. Tenderers that qualified in terms of the functionality criteria will then be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point system as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022.

Bidders/manufacturers must submit a SABS manufacturing Capability Report Certificate which is not older than twelve (12) months, which certifies the capability to manufacture the specific items tendered for, with their tender. On supply or delivery, the successful bidder will be required to submit the same.

Tenderers will be evaluated in terms of functionality as part of the minimum requirements before evaluated on price and preference based on the following criteria:
