#### 1. PURPOSE

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

The service provider will maintain and service the electrical needs of Limpopo Tourism Agency and the activities are, but not limited to:

- Maintenance and repairs of the air conditioners
- Maintenance of electrical equipment
- Repair of electrical faults
- Servicing and repair of the electrical gate including boom gates.
- Replacement and fitting/installation of electrical and air-conditioning equipment

#### NB:

The service provider must provide warranty of equipment installed and if the equipment installed or fitted is damaged before the time of warranty lapses, the service provider will be required to re-do the work.

#### 3. PHASE 3: EVALUATION IN TERMS OF PRICE AND PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

Only bids that achieve the minimum qualifying score/percentage for functionality will be evaluated further in accordance with the 80/20 preference point system prescribe in Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022.

The PPPFA prescribes that the lowest acceptable bid will score 80 points for price. Bidders that quoted higher prices will score lower points for price on a pro-rata basis.
