

- The eBooks should come without Digital Rights Management restrictions directly hosted on the publisher (provider)/aggregator platform (There might be some eBooks that have limitations from the publisher which then should be specific by the Service provider). If the publishers are Taylor Francis, Wiley, Cambridge and Springer (examples). These books should be accessible on the platforms developed by these publishers.
- The eBooks should be hosted for an unlimited period on the publisher platform and not only accessible for a short period for the PDF to be downloaded then access to eBook disappear. eRKC does not keep/distribute a single downloaded copy. It should be hosted on a reputable platform which offers search capabilities and for books to be downloaded by numerous HSRC users indefinitely (purchase) on the specific platform for the book purchased.
- It should have an administrative site for usage to be measured on a monthly basis.
- Access should be based on IP authentication (no username/password access).
