INTEGRATED REGULATORY PROCESSES FOR THE PROPOSED TAAIBOSCH PUTS ENERGY CLUSTER IN THE NORTHERN CAPE

Consultation Environmental Impact Reports Available for Public Review from 19 October to 20 November 2023

Jones & Wagener (Pty) Ltd Engineering and Environmental Consultants (J&W) is conducting the respective permitting processes, including respective applications for Environmental Authorisation (EA) (EIAs (Environmental Impact Assessments) and Basic Assessments (BAs), as applicable) and where relevant Atmospheric Emissions Licensing (AEL) for the proposed Taaibosch Puts Energy Cluster.

The Taaibosch Puts Energy Cluster consist of several distinct projects:

- Kora I-IV Solar PV Energy Facilities
- Koraqua I-V Solar PV Energy Facilities
- Khoemana Wind Energy Facility
- Gorachouqua I and II Wind Energy Facilities
- Korakobab Green Hydrogen Facility
- Kei Korana Green Ammonia Facility
- Electrical Grid Infrastructure for the various components of the project

The proposed components are located approximately 6 km west of Lime Acres, 28 km south-west of Danielskuil and 30 km east of Postmasburg in the Tsantsabane Municipality, Northern Cape. The proposed projects collectively comprise approximately 11 855 ha.

The applications are undertaken in terms of the 2014 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) regulations (as amended) in terms of Section 24 of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA), Act 107 of 1998 (as amended), the National Water Act (NWA), Act 36 of 1998 (as amended) and the National Environmental Management Air Quality Act (NEMA: AQA), Act 39 of 2004.

The Competent Authority for the application for the proposed Korakobab Green Hydrogen Facility and Kei Korana Green Ammonia Facility is the Northern Cape Department of Agriculture, Environmental Affairs, Rural Development and Land Reform (DAEARD&LR). The Consultation Environmental Impact Reports (CEIRs) and the Atmospheric Impact Report (AIR) for these specific projects will be made available for public review from **19 October to 20 November 2023**. The reports for the other components of the project will be available at a later stage.

Konsultasie-omgewingsimpakverslae beskikbaar vir insae deur die publiek van 19 Oktober tot 20 November 2023

Jones & Wagener (Pty) Ltd Engineering and Environmental Consultants (J&W) is aangestel om die onderskeie magtigingsprosesse te hanteer, insluitende waar van toepassing 'n Lugemissiesinsensie (LEL) en onderskeie aansoeke vir Omgewings-magtiging (OM) (OIB's en Basiese Bepalings, waar van toepassing) vir die voorgestelde Taaibosch Puts-energiekompleks.

ANC/EFF Coalition back in power at Gamagara

The acting speaker, Councillor Thataetsile Motsore presided over the special council meeting held on Wednesday 11 October 2023 after the accounting officer announced an

apology from the Speaker Councillor Shepherd Mines.

The meeting proceeded uninterrupted with its business as per the adopted council agenda tabled and approved by the acting Speaker Councillor Goitseone Sekgopi.

In a motion of no confidence placed on the agenda by the Chief Whip of the ANC Councillor Thapelo Tiroyame in the speaker Councillor Shepherd Mines and the mayor Councillor Henriëtte du Plessis, the council re-elected Councillor Goitseone Sekgopi from the EFF as the Speaker. Councillor Edwin Hantise was then re-elected as the mayor by virtue of him being part of the executive committee (exco) as the law dictates that only exco members are legible to stand for election as the mayor.

In the meantime, Councillor Edwin

Hantise tendered his resignation on 12 October 2023 offering personal commitments as the reason.

On Wednesday 18 October 2023 during another special council meeting, member of the exco Councillor Keloneilwe Dithupa tendered her resignation and Councillor Johannes Roman from the ANC was elected as exco member in her place and then as mayor of Gamagara.

Meanwhile, Harold McGluwa, MPL of the Democratic Alliance (DA), commented that the DA was disappointed by the ANC/EFF doomsday coalition's persistent attempts to cling to power, despite the obvious service delivery and governance gains made under a DA mayor.

The DA will continue working hard from the opposition benches, striving to hold the municipality

accountable and pushing for improved services.

The cost order in respect of the two interdicts that the DA won against two previous unlawful MONCS against the DA mayor, will proceed in the Kimberley High Court on 02 November 2023.

Sensus 2022 : Baie vrae

Ná die sensustyd verlede jaar, was die plaaslike publiek verslae aangesien niemand wat ek gevra het nie, besoek was nie.

Dit is aanvanklik beskou as 'n geïsoleerde dorpsaangeleentheid, maar later is uit alle oorde van die selfde ondervinding gehoor.

Hierdie oneffektiewe poging kan verreikende gevolge hê. 'n Kenner op die sensusgebied beskryf dit as 'n absurde sensus. 'n Belangrike faktor is dat die statistiek se bevindings onder andere gebruik word om begrotings en infrastruktuurprojekte te bepaal.

Die ondertelling word bereken op 31% (1 uit elke 3 mense) wat nie getel is nie. In 1996 was die ondertelling 10%, in 2001 was dit 17% en in 2011 was dit 14,7%. Ondertelling onder swart mense was tans 36,74%, bruin mense 44,93%, Indiërs en/of Asiate 72,50%, wit men-

se 61,64% en ander 65,03%, sê die hoof van Solidariteit se navorsingspan, Mnr Connie Mulder wat reeds sedert 2022 met die navorsing besig is.

Bogenoemde statistiek ten spyte van die feit dat veldwerkers 98% penetrasie by munisipaliteite aangegee word. Dr Phali Lehohla, voormalige Statikus Generaal sê egter dat die sensus betroubaar en geslaagd was. Hy sê dat volgens Stats-SA is daar geen internasionale standaard wat die drempel van die ondertellingskoers voorskryf nie. Die sensusstemproses wek egter kommer, aangesien 'n ondertelling van bo 22% in ander lande as 'n gevaar gesien word.

Verskeie faktore het die sensusproses ook bemoeilik sê Mnr Mulder; omheinde sekuriteitsgemeenskappe het die invul van vraelyste bemoeilik en kompensasië vir werk-

ers was te min.

Om vorentoe op dié wyse te gaan, is 'n ope vraag. Skattings en projek-sies word gedoen uit die beskikbare data om 'n akkurate beeld te verkry, maar is op laer vlakke nie betroubaar nie, sê Mnr Mulder. 'n Moontlike oplossing is om in areas met baie groot ondertellings nog 'n telling te hou om die bevestiging van data te verteenwoordig, ook om die volgende 2026 Sensus moontlik te vervroeg.

Solidariteit se eie 2022 sensus onder Afrikaners, wat reeds gedoen is, sal dalk gebruik word as hulp om die sensus se skeefftrekkings reg te stel.

Die man op straat wat die gebreke van die sensus waargeneem het, staan baie skepties oor die uitwerking en uitgawes wat wel aangegaan is.
