## **REQUEST FOR INFORMATION IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS (e.g. Accommodation, Adventure, Tourist facilities) WITHIN NWPTB RESERVES**

### **1. OVERVIEW**

The North West Parks and Tourism Board is a state-owned entity mandated to manage and control protected areas as well as promoting tourism within the North West Province. One of the core primary focus of the organization is the conservation of biodiversity in protected areas, with a secondary objective of stimulating economic opportunities for the ecotourism and wildlife sector.

The entity has developed the Commercialization Strategy for the protected areas under its management. The purpose of the strategy is to identify commercial opportunities in protected areas for the benefit of both the protected areas and the surrounding communities.

### **2. INFORMATION REQUESTED**

North West Parks and Tourism Board requests the information from interested suppliers/service providers on commercial projects/activities that can be introduced/developed in the identified protected areas/nature reserves/parks. Opportunities have been identified for accommodation facilities and adventure products in the following protected areas/nature reserves/parks:
