This addendum serves to clarify and amend specific details in the initial bid document.

Removal of ASATA Membership as a Mandatory Requirement page 19 item 10.1

Following clarification received from National Treasury, the requirement for bidders to submit an ASATA membership certificate as a mandatory returnable document has been removed from the Terms of Reference (TOR).

National Treasury confirmed that ASATA is a voluntary body and that ASATA membership is not mandatory. Only submission of a valid IATA certificate remains a mandatory requirement.

Following the briefing session held on 22nd of May 2026, the bid document has been further amended to retract requirements for bidders. This adjustment aims to ensure clarity and uniformity in the bidding process.

2. Effective Date
