TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A PANEL OF SERVICE PROVIDERS TO CONDUCT COMPETENCY BASED ASSESSMENT FOR SENIOR AND EXECUTIVE MANAGEMENT POSITIONS WITHIN THE SOUTH AFRICAN DIAMONDS AND PRECIOUS METALS REGULATOR

#### 1. PURPOSE

The South African Diamonds and Precious Metals Regulator (SADPMR) seeks to appoint a service provider to conduct competency-based assessment for senior and executive management positions to determine competencies essential for performance and indicating relative strengths and the potential for further development and recruitment purposes.

## 2. BACKGROUND

The SADPMR is listed as a Schedule 3A Public Entity pursuant to the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA). Amongst others, the SADPMR has a Recruitment Policy which aims to provide strategic organizational measures to ensure that the organization is able to attract candidates for leadership and technical positions within the SADPMR. The policy makes provision for use of competency-based assessment as an additional assessment tool to the interview as per requirements of the job. Competency based assessment allows an organisation to identify professional and personal characteristics needed for high performance in a given position.

#### 3. SCOPE OF WORK

It is expected that the appointed qualified service providers will conduct competency-based assessments as and when required for senior and executive management positions and provide an accurate predictor report of overall job success.

# 4. DELIVERABLES

- Conduct competency-based assessment for senior and executive management positions to measure observable behaviours candidates demonstrate resulting from various abilities, knowledge, motivations, traits and skills they possess.
- Provide comprehensive competency-based assessment report revealing potential employee advancement through evaluation of current strengths, skills gap and qualifications and therefore:
  - (i) Identifying individual strengths and weaknesses;
  - (ii) Provide evidence for needed development activities; and
  - (iii) Give recommendations through description of employee's capabilities against the requirements of the job.
- The selected service provider will be required to present the report to the Human Resources division.

# 5. MONITORING AND REPORTING

- The successful service providers will report directly to SADPMR Human Resources.
- The SCM Division will deal with matters relating terms of contract.

# 6. DURATION OF THE PROJECT

The SADPMR will conclude an agreement with the successful service provider for a period of three (3) years.
