

Clarification for RFQ 54342

REQUEST FOR QUOTATION FOR THE PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE DEVELOPERS TO INTEGRATE NEW DATA SOURCES INTO QLIK, MIGRATE QLIKVIEW REPORTS TO QLIK SENSE, CONVERT QVDS TO AZURE SYNAPSE, AND UPGRADE THE QLIKVIEW ENVIRONMENT FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING TWENTY-FOUR (24) MONTHS.

The questions are very similar, I have summarized and given context which should cover them.

The only question that I need you to advice on is in relation to the reference letters being restricted by NDA. Can they use case studies?

The rest of the questions can be answered by the following, do let me know if you need more information.

1. Currently we have about 40 unique QlikView reports/dashboards, no NPrinting, Qlik Sense or any other Qlik tools or products.
2. All the QlikView reports pull data from multiple sources which is then transformed within QlikView and stored into QVDs, the visualization then uses QVDs as the main source.
3. The intention of the project will focus on two streams, migration and moderation.
 - 3.1. Because the main data source is being migrated into a new platform, about 40% of the reports on QlikView will be affected so this will be the immediate priority. The new data source has different table and columns.

Bidders should assume that the current QlikView environment contains multiple business-critical dashboards, reports, and supporting QVD layers. The successful bidder will be expected to perform a detailed assessment to validate quantities, complexity and dependencies.

3.2. The second aspect then refers to modernizing the reporting platform into a modern BI platform, this includes moving away from QVDs and building a unified data platform and the visualization. The appointed service provider will be expected to assess the most appropriate deployment model and provide recommendations that align with ACSA's architectural standards, security requirements, scalability objectives, operational support model.

4. Data sources include SQL, Oracle, Smart sheets, Excel

5. The goal is to have a single data warehouse so post migration and modernization we expect to have no QVD logic in place, all that logic should reside in Azure.
6. The vendor will not be managing Azure subscriptions and administration; this is currently managed internally.
7. If the vendor wants to propose a hybrid delivery model, they must indicate this clearly on the submission.
8. The current version of QlikView is 12.5
