**ADDENDUM NO. 1**

**Addendum No. 1 incorporates the following changes:**

**Amendments:**

SECTION 2: CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- Paragraph 3: Additional Conditions of Contract
- The following conditions are hereby added to Section 2, Paragraph 3 of the RFP document and shall form part of the Conditions of Contract. These conditions shall be read in conjunction with all existing terms and conditions of the RFP. In the event of any conflict, the provisions of this addendum shall take precedence.

**CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

- 1.1 Where Transnet has identified opportunities of economic transformation and empowerment, Transnet will incorporate a contractual obligation for the winning bidder to execute the identified transformation objective as a condition of contract.
- 1.2 Each bidder interested in participating in this tender should be cognisant that it is a condition of contract for the winning bidder to be required to contract with Transnet on one of the following transformation initiatives:
  - a) Job creation and preservation
- 1.3 The bidder will be required to Create Job opportunities of the total value of the contract. The percentage determined shall not be lower than 10% of the total contract value
  - i) Quarterly reporting of the new jobs created and the details of the people employed over the duration of the contract.
  - ii) Submit within 30 days of reaching completion, end of the service or the delivery date for all work required, a final job creation report for all new jobs created for the duration of the contract.
    - a) Subcontracting

- i) The promotion of supplier development through sub-contracting 100% of the value of steel components which in this case are the steel fender panels and the fender support bars specified as per the below:
  - ii) Steel fender panel: 3610x2800x300mm – as per the drawing
  - iii) Cylindrical steel suspension bar with cleats: 120mm OD x 2700mm L – as per the drawing to contract to South African Companies which are:
  - iv) HDI's – Women, Youth and people with disabilities
  - v) Entities with a specified minimum B-BBEE level (1 and 2)
  - vi) EMEs and/or QSEs 51% black-owned
- 1.4 The successful bidder(s) will be required to meet the requirements of any condition stated in this section. **Failure to meet any of the conditions**, may result in the contract not being concluded between Transnet and the successful bidder.

The following sections in the RFP are replaced to reflect the changes:
