- Valid Copy B-BBEE Certificate issued by CIPC for EME's. OR
- Valid original or certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate / affidavit in the case of QSE's must be submitted, or
- Valid original or certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate issued by SANAS Accredited Verification Agency for Generic Entities must be submitted, or
- For JV's only valid original or certified copy B-BBEE Certificate issued by a SANAS Accredited Verification Agency will be accepted and the certificate should be in the name of the JV.

A tenderer failing to provide documentation for the allocation of preference points will not be disqualified, but (a) may only score points out of 90/80 for price and (b) scores 0 points out of 10/20 for specific goals.

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Section 2. Objective Criterion - may change award from the highest ranked tenderer to another tenderer in accordance with the requirements of the PPPFA [clause 2(1)(f)]:

The DTI together with the procuring organ of state and the winning bidder will consider the exemption on a case-by-case basis.

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Section 3. SDL&I – Contractual Requirements

Tenderers who complete and submit the undertaking as required, but who do not meet Eskom's targets, will not be disqualified. SD&L undertakings do not form part of the evaluation, but commitments will form part of contractual obligations

3.1. B-BBEE Requirements

(a) B-BBEE Certificate:

The Contractor is expected to submit a B-BBEE Certificate or Sworn Affidavit before Contract Award if not submitted for Tender Evaluation.

(b) Maintain and/or improve B-BBEE Status:

Awarded Contract is expected to maintain or improve their B-BBEE Recognition Level for the duration of the contract.

3.2. Skills Development

The Contractor's Skills Development Goals (CSDG) will not be applicable as the duration is less than 12 months according to the Procurement Strategy.

As this Project is of limited duration, therefore there are limited opportunities for formal skills development. However, the Contractor may provide on the job training for graduates/artisans in the fields of electricity/electronics and/or access control systems. The numbers will be negotiated.

3.3. Job Opportunities

Tenderers are required to maximise employment of general, semi-skilled and skilled employees from the underdeveloped areas or townships in the vicinity of MWP, when opportunities arise.

Section 4: SD&L Performance Bond

The Contractor shall submit an SDL&I Performance Guarantee equivalent to 1.5% of the Contract Value and shall only be released to the Contractor upon fulfilment of all SDL&I Obligations or alternatively, the retention of 1.5% of every invoice will be deducted if the tenderer cannot afford to raise the bond.
