1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. Sakhisizwe Local Municipality is a Category B municipality covering the towns of Cala and Khowa.
- 1.2. The municipality is currently developing a communication strategy which is in line with the Integrated Development Plan of the Institution. The development of the communication strategy has four phases and the media training is the first phase in the development of the communication strategy.
- 1.3. There is a need, for Sakhisizwe Local Municipality, to communicate with the stakeholders on a continuous basis. The Communication strategy will ensure that this ideal is achieved.

PHASE 1: MEDIA TRAINING

1. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

- 1.1. A service provider with expertise and capacity to do media training will be required to do training in the following priority areas:
 - Communication as a tool for service delivery
 - Profiling Leadership, protocol and etiquette
 - Defining roles in the communication value chain
 - Explaining and simplifying service delivery to citizens
 - Civic Education
 - Practical training in radio and television interviews including real time mock interviews

PHASE 2: DEVELOPMENT OF THE DRAFT COMMUNICATION STRATEGY

2.1 SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

The service provider is required to conduct the media training and produce a draft communication strategy that will be partially informed by the media training as well as the communication policy which the municipality will provide. The media training and draft communication strategy must be aligned to:
