

- Once the training has actual happened the service provider will register the leaners or book the learners for a learner's license test.
- The learners will be expected to go and write test.
- The service provider will be expected to pay for the fees that would be required for booking licence, and the Certificate and also pay for temporal learner's licence.

Learner to be tutored for at least two hours for the period of three days consisting of three modules.

1. Road Signs
2. Rules of the road
3. Controls of a vehicle
4. Include leaners Certificate fees paid once a learner passed.

For the purposes of this tender the tenderer will be allocated points based on the goals stated in table 1 below as may be supported by proof/ documentation stated in the conditions of this tender:
- 4.2. In cases where organs of state intend to use Regulation 3(2) of the Regulations, which states that, if it is unclear whether the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system applies, an organ of state must, in the tender documents, stipulate in the case of—
  - (a) an invitation for tender for income-generating contracts, that either

the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the highest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system; or

(b) any other invitation for tender, that either the 80/20 or 90/10 preference point system will apply and that the lowest acceptable tender will be used to determine the applicable preference point system,

then the organ of state must indicate the points allocated for specific goals for both the 90/10 and 80/20 preference point system.
