T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

The Knysna Municipality invites tenders for the **KNYSNA CBD EMERGENCY SEWER REHABILITATION**

There will not be a compulsory tender clarification meeting, save that queries and clarification questions will be taken and answered through the constructiontenders@knysna.gov.za. However, the municipality has set a non-compulsory site briefing on the 23rd February 2024 at 10h00 at the Corner of Mortimer Street and Corner of Long Street and Union Street. Tenders are encouraged to register their emails on constructiontenders@knysna.gov.za to receive the project related information and relevant changes and make use of the Tender Number on the email subject. Failure to register bidder's email may lead to crucial information missing in the bidder's tender and therefore may be regarded as non-responsive. Closing time for registration and answering of queries and clarification seeking emails will be five (5) days prior to tender closing. No queries/questions will be taken after the set time for queries or questions.

The closing time for submission of bids is **12:00 on Friday, 08th March 2024**. Bids must be sealed in an envelope clearly marked with the bid number and title given above and placed in the bid box at the Supply Chain Management Unit, Finance Building, Queen Street, Knysna, on or before the mentioned time and latest date. Telephonic, facsimile and late bids will not be accepted. Bids must remain valid for a period of 120 days after the closing date of the bid. Notwithstanding the period for validity of bids as set out in the bid documents, the Knysna Municipality reserves the right to request extension of tender validity period. Bids will be opened on the same day at the Supply Chain Management Section at 12:00. Late or unmarked bids will not be considered.

The evaluation of this bid will be subjected to functionality scoring. Tenderers must achieve a minimum functionality score of **70 out of 100** points for functionality in order to be evaluated further. The functionality criteria and weighting is set out in the tender document.

Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued.

Bids will be evaluated according to the **80/20** preference points system. The bids are subject to the Council Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2023.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Further requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of bids are stated in the Tender Document.

It is estimated that tenderers must have a **CIDB contractor designation of 3 CE** or higher.
