- Tender documents must be downloaded or purchased and collected prior to the starting time of the pretender briefing meeting.
- 6. No tender documents will be issued at the pre-tender briefing meeting and no site inspection meeting certificates will be issued at the pre-tender briefing meeting.
- 7. No late arrivals will be accepted to the pre-tender briefing meeting.
- 8. Submission of a PDF copy of the completed bid tender document, together with all supporting tender documents, must be submitted on a readable flash drive with the bid at the close of tender.
- 9. The Bill of Quantities shall be fully priced and submitted with the bid document on or before the tender closing date.

- 11. Faxed or e-mailed bids are not accepted.
- 12. Only Bidders registered on the Central Suppliers Database and within the applicable CIDB grading or higher as stated above are eligible to submit bids.
