TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR

APPOINTMENT OF PANEL (MAXIMUM OF 03) SERVICE PROVIDERS TO PERFORM INVESTIGATION SUPPORT FOR MPAC FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS (AS AND WHEN REQUIRED)

BACKGROUND

The Elias Motsoaledi Local Municipality (EMLM) is located in the Sekhukhune District of the Limpopo Province. It is one of four municipalities in the district. The seat of the municipality is Groblersdal. The primary functions of the Municipal Public Accounts Committee are as follows:

- 1. To review and evaluate the content of the annual report and to make recommendations to Council when adopting an oversight, report on the annual report;
- 2. In the case of matters not finalized, information relating to past recommendations made on the Annual Report, must also be reviewed. This relates to current in-year reports, including the quarterly, mid-year and annual reports. This exercise must be geared to the remedy for problems rather than simply reporting on issues that remain persistently unresolved;
- 3. To examine the financial statements and audit reports of the municipality. This review must identify shifts and improvements from previous statements and reports. It must also assess the extent to which the Audit Committee's and the Auditor-General's recommendations have been implemented and seek explanation when no or ineffective actions have followed:
- 4. To promote good governance, transparency and accountability and value for money in the use of municipal resources;
- 5. To recommend or undertake any investigation in its area of responsibility, after reviewing any investigation report already undertaken by the municipality or the Audit Committee;
- 6. To perform any other functions assigned to it through a resolution of Council within its area of responsibility.

3 OBJECTIVE

The objective of the proposed work is to:

1. Provide the MPAC with investigation support as an when council refers matters of investigation to its committee. To provide MPAC with a detailed assessment of potential risks which may arise during the year as identified by council.

4 SCOPE OF WORKS

In terms of this RFP the service provider is required to assist the MPAC Committee to provide a competent and experienced team of accounting and risk professionals who have the requisite skills to deliver on the objective of this RFP. The audit firm will be specifically contracted to:

- 1.To perform investigation support for MPAC for a period of three years as and when required.
- 2. Perform a risk assessment and determine if findings and matters referred to by council has been resolved.
- 3. Perform a holistic risk assessment on any other potential findings which may result in a qualified audit opinion and;
- 4. Perform a detailed report with management including recommendations and performance indicators required to achieve an unqualified opinion.
- 5. The service provider will be required to transfer the skill to the team that they will be working with during their term of service.
