5.1 Mandatory Tender Returnables (Stage 1)

Please note that if any of the requested evidence stated below is not submitted and fully compliant, the tenderer will be disqualified without Eskom requesting the tenderer to submit outstanding documentation. Eskom will treat all documents submitted as confidential.

5.1.1 Technical File

A file containing evidence of all mandatory and functional requirements shall be submitted separately from any other non-technical tender submissions. It is advisable that the tenderer should utilise the exact same file numbering/order as per this document to assist the Eskom evaluation team in locating the evidence.

5.1.2 Design

Pole designs shall be done by an ECSA registered professional technologist/engineer.

Proof to be submitted:

- a) Certified copy of ECSA registration certificate of the design technologist/engineer (Name and ECSA number).
- b) Submission of Table 1: ECSA Registered Design Technologist/Engineer's Details.

Plasma/laser cutter

Plasma/laser cutter shall be able to cut ≤ 20mm plate.

Proof to be submitted:

- a) The machine including all relevant information (name, model- and serial numbers) shall appear on Table 2: Mandatory Machine List Requirements ${\bf or}$,

5.1.4 Bending brake

Bending brake shall be at least 10m in length and capable of bending 8mm plate.

Proof to be submitted:

- b) If subcontracting this function, submit letter of agreement and all relevant information (name, model- and serial numbers) must appear on Table 2: Mandatory Machine List Requirements.

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5.1.5 Submerged arc welder

Submerged arc welder shall be at least 10m in length and capable of performing full penetration welds on 8mm plate.

Proof to be submitted:

- a) The machine including all relevant information (name, model- and serial numbers) must appear on Table 2: Mandatory Machine List Requirements **or**,
- b) If subcontracting this function, submit letter of agreement and all relevant information (name, model- and serial numbers) must appear on Table 2: Mandatory Machine List Requirements.

5.2 Evaluation of Functionality Threshold (Stage 2)

The following aspects will be evaluated based on information provided. The tenderer shall complete Table 4: Functionality Threshold Scoring in Appendix A.

A minimum score of 8 out of 11 is required in order to pass this technical evaluation stage.

5.2.1 POLASA Membership

Tenderers whom are members of POLASA shall submit proof of membership. Note that only membership in the name of the tendering company will contribute to the final score.

5.2.2 Drawing Office

Tenderers shall indicate the availability of an in-house drawing office with CAD operators. Tenderers should also list the design drawing software used in Table 4: Functionality Threshold Scoring.

5.2.3 Previous related manufacturing experience

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5.2.4 Galvanising

Tenderers shall provide galvanising bath dimensions and details of the galvanizing process relating to single dipping or double dipping of pole sections.

For single dipping note that the minimum galvanising bath length shall be 13.5m for diameters of up to 1.3m and 9.5m for diameters up to 1.8m.

5.2.5 Workshop space

Tenderers shall indicate whether the factory has a dedicated area for pole manufacturing. This space should be adequate for handling and preferably separated from other unrelated works.

Specify the dedicated workshop space area m2.

5.2.6 Handling

Tenderers shall indicate whether the factory has an overhead gantry crane (specify the load capacity) **or**, whether the factory only utilise a forklift (specify the load capacity).

Poles need to be proven to be handled safely; as such the use of an overhead gantry crane will be preferred.

5.2.7 Loading and storage

Tenderers shall indicate whether the factory has a dedicated area for purposes of safe storage and access for trucks during loading of poles for transport during all stages of manufacturing i.e. pre- and post-galvanising activities etc.

Specify the dedicated factory storage space area m2.

5.3 Scoring of Functionality Threshold

The scoring for section 5.2 shall be as indicated in Table 4: Functionality Threshold Scoring. Note that only one score may be applied per item and a minimum score of 8 out of 11 is required to be successful.

Failure by the tenderer to meet a minimum threshold of 80% for Functionality will lead to immediate disqualification.

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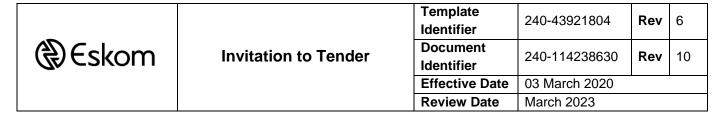
